Admission requirements - all applicants must demonstrate the knowledge of foreign (English) language at the level high enough to follow the curriculum during the lectures and collaborate with a teacher during practical training

Course objectives (aims) – providing insights into the state of special and inclusive education in Russia and abroad from a historical perspective and at the present times

Course contents – Module 1. Traditions of special and inclusive education all over the world. Module 2. Traditions of special and inclusive education in modern Russia. Module 3. The current state of special and included education in Russia and all over the world.

Learning outcomes – the process of learning is aimed at forming the elements of the following competences in accordance with the requirements of Federal Educational Standard of Higher Education (3++) by field of study 44.04.03 Special (defectologic) education: Universal competence 4 - the ability to implement modern communicative technologies, including those in foreign languages for academic and professional collaboration; Universal competence 5 – the ability to analyse and consider the variety of cultures in the process of interculturality; General professional competence 4 – the ability to form and implement the conditions and principles of spiritual and moral education on the basis of national values. Professional competence 1 – the ability to design and implement special educational process in educational institutions in accordance with modern defectologic and pedagogic sciences achievements.

Planned learning activities and teaching methods (for ex., lectures with a variety of examples and practice): lectures – 10 hours, practical training – 22 hours, students independent studies – 148 hours. Among the technologies implemented on the lessons are context learning technology, design learning technology, interview and discussion technology.
