Course objectives (aims)	<p>The primary objective of the course is to study establishment and development of soviet ideology and its transformation after the collapse of Soviet Union.</p> <p>It is purposed to help students to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - examine of features of Soviet ideology; - reveal the influence of ideology on the state development
Course contents	The course is divided into two broad parts. The first concerns the theory and practice of political ideologies and special aspects soviet ideology, and the second is about the development of ideology in new political conditions
