Sociology of public opinion

Ethnosociology

The aim of the course is to generalize and systematize the scientific and theoretical foundations of the sociological analysis of ethnic relations and practical tasks related to the regulation of interethnic relations. The program involves the development of key concepts and basic categories of science, historical forms of ethnicity, the structure of ethnic psychology, forms and methods of ethnic interactions. The objectives of the course are to operate with key ethnosociological concepts and categories, develop students' skills in scientific analysis of individual components of ethnic relations and organizations, practical skills to apply the knowledge gained in the analysis of modern ethnic processes, the ability to professionally assess situations of interethnic interactions, to navigate in a modern multi-ethnic environment 5 ZET.
